

LAFAYETTE TOPPLES GENEVA, 10-7

GENEVA — LaFayette's Lancers handily defeated Geneva here yesterday for the Upstate Lacrosse Conference crown. The score of the playoff game was 10-7 and it was easier than it sounds.

With 2:11 left to go, the unbeaten Lancers had a 9-3 lead and JV players came in to spell the regulars in this championship finale. Geneva scored twice quickly, before the varsity scurried back to score once while Geneva added its last goal.

A crowd of more than 1,000, 770 of them paid, watched the Lancers roll up their 16th win of the season and 21st straight. Alfie Jacques with four goals and two assists and Bob Shaw, with three goals and an assist, led the attack.

Travis Cook, who wound up with 56 goals, Dave Miler and Ron Doctor all added a goal while Ronnie had three assists, to up his season total to 46. Slug Hill and Steve Wood also had assists.

Doctor and John Porter controlled the faceoffs, for the Eastern Division titlists, taking every one until the JVs appeared.

Geneva's strong attack accounted for all their scoring. Mike Ryan had three goals and two assists for the Eastern Division champs and Jon Ryan and Mike Mahoney each had two goals and an assist.
